- Focuses on triage documentation and communication (e.g., purpose, format, and content of written and oral reports)
- Focuses on parallel investigations and multiple tools.

DAY 2

Advanced principles of violence risk assessment and management

- Discuss advanced violence risk assessment and management principles, including case formulation and scenario planning
- Practice case formulation and scenario planning with sample cases

DAY 3

Writing short reports

- Discuss core components of writing short reports
- Review case #1 and administer the HCR-20^{V3}
- Write short report based on case #1

DAY 4

Writing long reports

- Discuss core components of writing long reports
- Review case #2 and administer the HCR-20^{V3}
- Write long report based on case #2

DAY 5

Communicating oral reports and conducting expert testimony

- Discuss core components of risk communication
- Practice oral report based on case #2
- Discuss general principles for conducting expert testimony
- Practice expert testimony based on case #2

Daily Schedule

The Workshop runs from 0900 to 1630 each day, with refreshment breaks in the morning and afternoon and a lunch break from 1200 to 1300.

Registration is from 0830 to 0900 on the first day of the Workshop.
